**Facts:** Plaintiff, 43 year-old ex-Big League baseball pitcher employed as a furniture salesman, was standing on a street corner when the Defendant made a left turn in front of an on-coming vehicle. This resulted in a collision. In the course of action, the vehicles smashed the Plaintiff's leg against a lamp post.

**Injuries:** Severe cosmetic deformity and circulatory problems. The Plaintiff has a slight limp and is required to frequently elevate his leg to increase circulation.

**Medical Costs:** \$80,000

**Contentions:** Plaintiff claimed that the injury affected his future employability.

**Settlement:** \$2,250,000
