Plaintiff 43 year old commercial pilot, on a layover at a hotel. While taking a shower, the grab bar on the shower wall suddenly came out and he fell hitting his head. He was taken to the emergency hospital and released after negative x-rays and negative CT scan. All future CT scans and EEGs were negative.

INJURIES: Memory losses, severe headaches, inability to fly.

DEFENSE: Claimed accident impossible, no prior incidents or problems with grab bars and that plaintiff knew that the small airline for which he worked was on the verge of bankruptcy, and that plaintiff would have had extreme difficulty in getting future employment because of the bankruptcy, irrespective of the accident.
